UNBEATABLE BOY WESTERHOF

The 25 year old Dutch player, Boy Westerhof was the winner of the PORTO OPEN's 12th edition after the final against the Russian Stanislas Vovk. In the final, at the Clube de Ténis do Porto's central court Westerhof (440.^o) beat Vovk (534.^o) by 7-5, 6-0 in order to get the largest piece of the 15 thousand dollar prize-money cake.

The final was very even matched until the 12th game. At that time, Vovk committed two double-faults that gave way to the n^o 7 seeded-player. In the second set the 20 year old Russian could not go on and so Westerhof concluded the match after 1 hour and 10 minutes.

"I played well, at 6-5, he got nervous and made mistakes. The second set was easy. It was a great week and it was good to improve on my ranking. I hope to come back to Portugal and play in the Estoril Open, two years from now", said Westerhof after getting the fourth title in the pro circuit.

Vovk was satisfied with his presence in the final, despite leaving tired and with cramps.
